Class of 2012 - School of Humanities & Social Sciences

A total of 405 Humanities & Social Sciences graduates were awarded baccalaureate degrees in August 2011, December 2011, and May 2012. 205 (50%) graduates responded to the surveys administered by the Career Center and the Center for Institutional Effectiveness. The Admissions Clearinghouse identified an additional 28 members of the class that attended graduate or professional school in their first year after graduation.

POST GRADUATION ACTIVITY

Further Study

A total of 70 (34%) of those who *responded* indicated that they attended graduate school immediately after graduation. This reflects a 2 percentage point increase in comparison to the Class of 2011

Employment

A total of 158 (77%) graduates indicated they are employed. Their employment status is as follows:

108 (53%) indicated they were employed full time

50 (24%) indicated they were employed part time

63 (31%) indicated they were employed and in graduate school.

7 (3%) indicated they were unemployed, but were attending graduate school.

7 (3%) indicated they were both unemployed and not attending graduate school.

Average Salaries

102 (94%) respondents who were employed full time provided salary information.

All salary information is calculated using the actual salary the respondent provided or the median of the salary range selected by the respondent. Respondents that indicated their salaries fell below \$19,999 or above \$80,000 and did not include a precise amount were excluded from the calculations.

The mean reported salary for the respondents that met the above criteria is \$37,747. This reflects a 2 % increase in comparison to the Class of 2011.

Fields of Employment

Students pursue occupations in a variety of career fields. The 95 (98%) respondents that answered this item regarding employment fields are employed as follows:

17 (16%) in Business

2 (2%) in Government

15 (14%) in Human/Social Service

15 (14%) in Communications

2 (2%) in Allied Health

7 (8%) in other fields

1 (<1%) in Computers

11 (11%) in Law

33 (32%) in Education

1 (<1%) in Science

Time Span from Graduation to Employment

37 (36%) Humanities & Social Sciences graduates secured employment prior to graduation.

49 (57%) respondents secured employment within the first three months after graduation.

65 (63%) respondents secured employment within the first six months after graduation.

77 (74%) respondents secured employment within one year of graduation.

Job Offers

Of the Humanities & Social Sciences graduates employed who responded to this item, 38 (35%) of the 108 respondents employed full time received more than one job offer. The number of employment offers received ranged from 1 to 6, with respondents receiving a mean of 1.49 offers of employment per graduate.

Satisfaction with Employment

Revised Date: 8/8/2013

Using a likert scale of 5 high to 1 low, Humanities & Social Sciences graduates indicated the level of satisfaction they felt with their jobs. 76 (70%) of the respondents employed indicated an above average or high level of job satisfaction. The average satisfaction score for the respondents to this item was 4.09.

Current Employment's Ability to Meet Expectations

- 62 (39%) respondents indicated working in the field they expected.
- 69 (44%) respondents indicated working in the position type they expected.

Relationship between Academic Major and Position Obtained

Humanities & Social Sciences graduates indicated the relationship between their academic major and the position they obtained since graduation.

- 82 (40%) respondents indicated a direct relationship between their academic major and the position they obtained.
- 62 (30%) respondents indicated an indirect relationship between their academic major and the position they obtained.
- 33 (16%) respondents indicated there was no relationship between their academic major and the position they obtained.

Internship Participation

138 (67%) of Humanities & Social Sciences majors who responded to the survey indicated they participated in an average of 2.28 internship experiences over an average of 2.50 semesters.

Usage of The Career Center

163 (80%) respondents indicated they had utilized Career Services during their academic careers. Using a likert scale of 5 high to 1 low, graduates who utilized Career Services were asked to rate the service provided. The average rating was 3.78.

138 (60%) respondents reported utilizing TCNJ recruitment programs (i.e., internship programs and resources, job listings, on-campus recruitment and Career Days).

Receipt of Advice from Faculty

When asked if they had received advice from faculty in their department or program, respondents indicated they had.

- 104 (63%) indicated they had received advice regarding post graduation career plans.
- 90 (55%) indicated they had received advice regarding internships.
- 94 (24%) indicated they had received advice regarding graduate and professional school.
- 19 (12%) indicated they received advice but did not indicated the topic.

TCNJ's Preparation for Students' Career Goals

Humanities & Social Sciences graduates rated how TCNJ prepared them for their current position utilizing a five-point scale (i.e., excellent to poor). Of the 177 (76%) respondents, 124 (70%) rated their preparation as excellent or above average. The average rating was 3.97.

Quality of Academic Experience

Humanities & Social Sciences graduates assessed the overall quality of their academic experience. Of the 177(76%) respondents, 158 (89%) assessed their academic experience as excellent or above average. The average rating was 4.49.

GRADUATE/PROFESSIONAL SCHOOL

Current Graduate/Professional School Attendance

127 (55%) of respondents indicated that they applied for graduate/professional school in the first year after graduation. Of the survey respondents and clearinghouse report, 118 (51%) are currently enrolled in graduate/professional school.

Future Plans for Graduate Study

118 (51%) individuals indicated they are attending graduate/professional school, 156 (76%) respondents plan to attend further study. 94 (40%) of graduates indicated the timing of their future attendance in graduate school:

47 (50%) respondents plan to attend within the first 2 years after graduation.

88 (94%) respondents plan to attend within 4 years after graduation.

94 (100%) respondents plan to attend within 6 years after graduation.

Current Degrees and Highest Degree Level Sought

84 (71%) of those currently attending responded to the degree level they are pursuing. In addition, 191 (82%) graduates provided information on the highest degree level they intended to pursue. Of those intending to pursue advanced degrees:
