#### Class of 2013 - School of Humanities & Social Sciences

A total of 363 School of Humanities & Social Sciences students graduated during the academic school year of Fall 2012 – Spring 2013. 117 (32%) responded to the First Year Out Survey distributed by the Career Center. The Admissions Clearinghouse further identified 77 School of Humanities & Social Sciences graduates that are currently attending graduate or professional school.

# **Post-Graduation Activity**

## **Employment**

Of the 117 respondents, 84 (72%) indicated that they were working. Of those 84, 44 (52%) specified that they were working full-time and 16 (19%) specified that they were working part-time.

#### Fields of Employment

Of the 44 graduates employed full-time, 43 (98%) specified which fields their careers fell into:

5 (12%) in Administrative Services/Clerical
1 (2%) in Hospitality/Food Services
1 (2%) in Arts
4 (9%) in Law/Law Related

8 (19%) in Business 4 (9%) in Mental Health 1 (2%) in Communications 1 (2%) in Research 10 (23%) in Education 3 (7%) in Retail

1 (2%) in Engineering 3 (7%) in Social Services 1 (2%) in Other fields

#### **Average Salaries**

Of the 44 graduates employed full-time, 43 (98%) provided their salary information based on a range from "\$19,999 and under" to "\$85,000 and more" with \$5,000 intervals. The average salary for these graduates was \$35,545. This reflects a 5.8% decrease with comparison to the Class of 2012.

#### **Number of Job Offers**

Of the 44 graduates employed full-time, 27 (61%) received more than one job offer, with an average of 2.44 offers per graduate.

# **Experiential Learning/Internship Participation**

Of the 117 survey respondents, 51 (44%) indicated that they participated in at least one internship during their time at TCNJ, while 23 (45%) of them participated in internships for two or more semesters. Additionally, 7 participated in student teaching, 1 participated in a clinical placement, 4 participated in MUSE, 3 participated in TCNJ-sponsored research, and 5 participated in outside research.

# **Career Preparedness**

Of the 117 survey respondents, 54 (46%) rated how prepared they felt for their careers due to their time at TCNJ. Their ratings were based on a 5-point Likert scale (1 = Poor, 5 = Excellent):

#### Graduate/Professional School

Of the 117 survey respondents, 34 (30%) indicated that they were currently attending graduate school and the Clearinghouse supplied information on 77 more graduates, resulting in a total of 111 Humanities and Social Sciences graduates currently in graduate school.

## **Future Plans for Study**

Of the 117 survey respondents, 29 (25%) indicated that they had plans for beginning graduate school in the next few years:

- 5 (17%) applied and are waiting to decide/hear back.
- 17 (59%) intend to begin graduate school within 2 years.
- 6 (21%) intend to begin graduate school within 4 years.
- 1 (3%) intend to begin graduate school within 6 years.

## **Degrees Being Sought**

Of the 117 survey respondents, 73 (62%) indicated that they were planning on (if not actively) pursuing further degrees in the future;

- 1 (1%) is/will be seeking a Bachelor's Degree.
- 1 (1%) is/will be seeking a specialist degree.
- 30 (41%) are/will be seeking Master's Degrees.
- 10 (14%) are/will be seeking professional degrees.
- 24 (33%) are/will be seeking Doctoral Degrees.
- 1 (1%) is/will be pursuing a dual program.
- 6 (8%) are/will be seeking other degrees.

#### **Graduate/Professional School Preparedness**

Of the 34 survey respondents that are attending graduate school, 32 (94%) rated how prepared they felt for graduate school due to their time at TCNJ. Their ratings were based on a 5-point Likert scale (1 = Poor, 5 = Excellent):

Of the 117 survey respondents, 93 (79%) indicated that they had received some sort of advisement from their faculty advisor regarding their post-graduation plans:

- 73 (78%) reported receiving career advice.
- 72 (77%) reported receiving internship/experiential learning advice.
- 73 (78%) reported receiving graduate/professional school advice.

## **Usage of Career Center**

Of the 117 survey respondents, 93 (79%) indicated that they had utilized one or more of the Career Center's programs and/or services:

- 60 (65%) reported receiving Individual Major/Career Counseling.
