What kind of work?



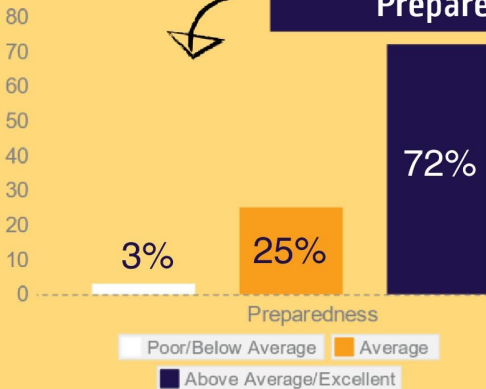
This was higher than the average reported through the NACE (National Association of Colleges and Employers) of \$51,508.
