The average salary of respondents was \$43,409.



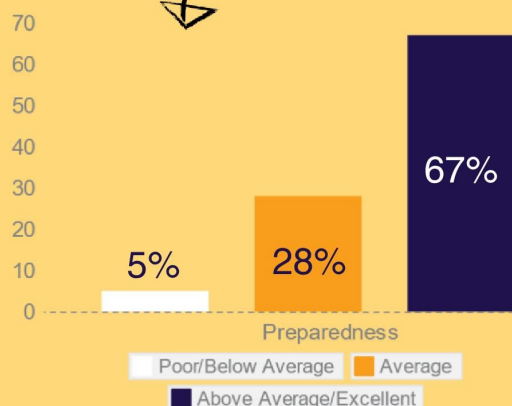
