The average salary of respondents was \$42,356.



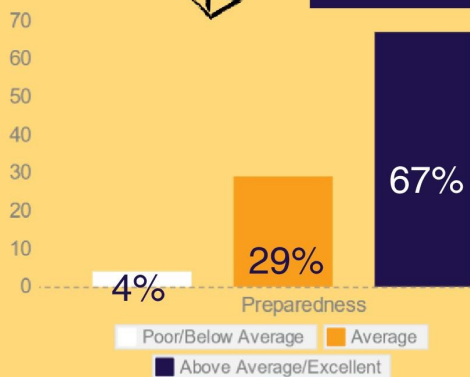
