

ONE YEAR OUT SURVEY: TCNJ CLASS OF 2015



⇒ **69%** of the class of 2015 responded to the One Year Out survey, incorporating data from Clearinghouse, Business, and Engineering exit surveys



⇒ **97%** reported they were employed and/or attending graduate/professional school

84% of the respondents were working
 ↳ **90%** full-time **10%** part-time

⇒ **46%** indicated attendance at graduate school within the first year

⇒ **36%** of those attending graduate school received full tuition reimbursement

⇒ **48%** received attending graduate school received partial tuition reimbursement
