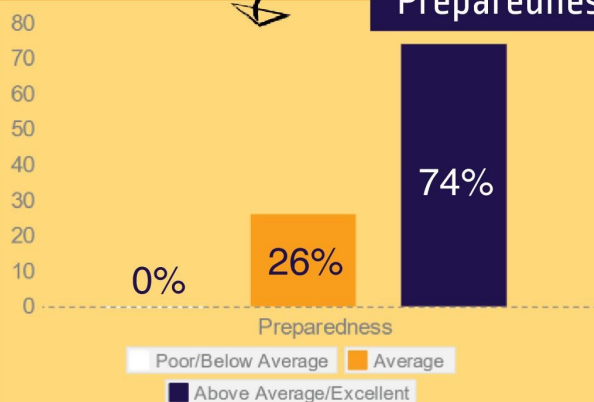
The average salary of TCNJ Computer Science majors was \$66,250 -- higher than the average of \$61,287 reported through NACE (National Association of Colleges and Employers)
