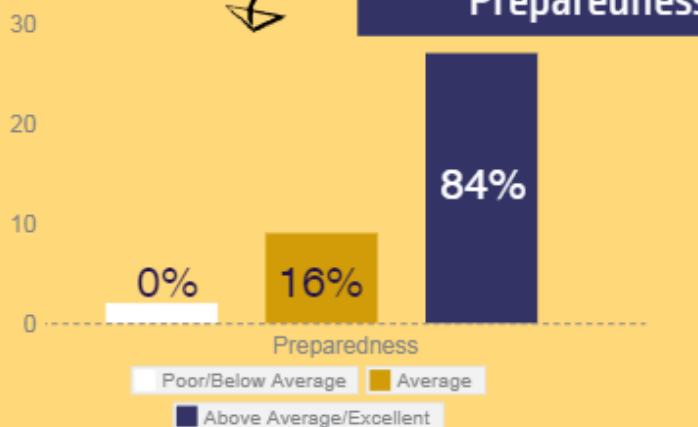
Salary
