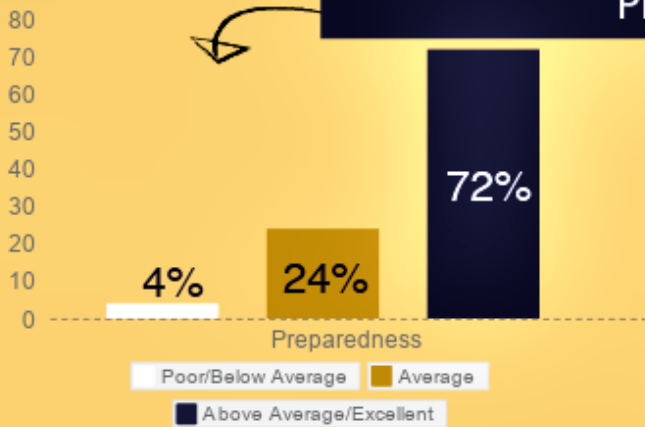


The average salary of respondents was \$65,100
