### ONE YEAR OUT REPORT: CLASS OF 2019

Information was obtained for 61.9% (232/375) of School of Humanities and Social Sciences graduates who were awarded their bachelor's degree in August 2018, December 2018, and May 2019. Among the 232 graduates, 97.0% (225/232) reported employment or continuing education plans, and 2.6% (6/232) reported no employment and currently searching for a job, and 0.4% (1/232) reported not employed, nor currently searching for a job. Of the 225 reporting employment or continuing education, 43.1% (100/232) were employed, 53.4% (124/232) were continuing education, and 0.4% (1/232) were in the military.



## **EMPLOYMENT**

Among the 100 Class of 2019 graduates reporting employment, 91.0% (91/100) were employed full time and 8.0% (8/100) were employed part time. One (1) graduate did not report their employment type. Below are details on employment trends among those reporting full-time employment.

#### **SALARY TRENDS**

The median salary reported is \$47,500, based on 42 graduates; this is a decrease compared to the Class of 2018 average salary of \$49,049. The median salary for females is \$52,500 with 30 reporting, and the median salary for males is \$37,500 with 12 reporting.

#### **JOB OFFERS**

Among the 44 graduates in full-time positions reporting job offer count, here is a breakdown:

#### MAJOR RELATION

Among the 100 reporting full-time employment, 44 indicated whether their major was directly related to their position. 43.2% (19/44) reported direct relation, 36.4% (16/44) reported indirect relation, and 20.5% (9/44) reported no relation.

## **CONTINUING EDUCATION**

124 graduates reported continuing education. Continuing education includes those pursuing graduate and professional school, or further studies including a second bachelor's degree, certifications, or specialized training. Below are details on continuing education trends among those in this category.

#### **MAJOR RELATION**

Among the 124 reporting continuing education, 62 indicated whether their major was directly related to their program. 62.9% (39/62) reported direct relation, 29% (18/62) reported indirect relation, and 8.1% (5/62) reported no relation.

## **CONTINUING EDUCATION (cont'd)**

#### **DEGREE LEVEL**

Among the 124 reporting continuing education, 66 indicated the degree level they are pursuing. 60.6% (40/66) are pursuing a master's degree, 34.8% (23/66) are pursuing a doctorate degree, 3% are pursuing a certificate, and 1.5% (1/66) are pursuing a second bachelor's degree.

#### PROGRAM ACCEPTANCE RATE

Among the 124 reporting continuing education, 60 reported the number of program acceptances they received. 45% (27/60) received one (1) acceptance, 16.7% (10/60) received two (2) acceptances, and 38.3% (23/60) received three or more acceptances.

#### **FUTURE PLANS FOR STUDY**

Among the Class of 2019 graduates responding to the survey, 109 indicated they were planning on (if not actively) pursuing further degrees in the future. Additionally, 47 indicated their plans and timeline for beginning graduate school. Below is a breakdown on these data points.

#### CAREER AND GRADUATE SCHOOL PREPARATION
