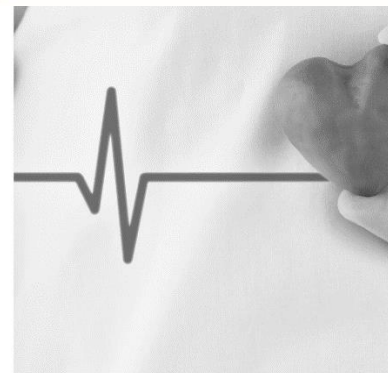


SCHOOL OF NURSING, HEALTH & EXERCISE SCIENCE



ONE YEAR OUT REPORT: CLASS OF 2019

Information was obtained for 57.4% (97/169) of School of Nursing, Health and Exercise Science graduates who were awarded their bachelor's degree in August 2018, December 2018, and May 2019. Among the 97 graduates, 97.9% (95/97) reported employment or continuing education plans, and 2.1% (2/97) reported no employment and currently searching for a job. Of the 97 reporting employment or continuing education, 40.2% (39/97) were employed, 57.7% (56/97) were continuing education, and 2.1% (2/97) were not employed and currently searching for a job.



EMPLOYMENT

Among the 39 Class of 2019 graduates reporting employment, 94.9% (37/39) were employed full time and 5.1% (2/39) were employed part time. Below are details on employment trends among those reporting full-time employment.

SALARY TRENDS

The median salary reported is \$67,500, based on 23 graduates; this is an increase compared to the Class of 2018 average salary of \$65,149. The median salary for females is \$67,500 with 19 reporting, and the median salary for males is \$57,500 with 4 reporting.

JOB OFFERS

Among the 23 graduates in full-time positions reporting job offer count, here is a breakdown:

MAJOR RELATION

Among the 37 reporting full-time employment, 23 indicated whether their major was directly related to their position. 73.9% (17/23) reported direct relation, 21.7% (5/23) reported indirect relation, and 4.3% (1/23) reported no relation.

CONTINUING EDUCATION

56 graduates reported continuing education. Continuing education includes those pursuing graduate and professional school, or further studies including a second bachelor's degree, certifications, or specialized training. Below are details on continuing education trends among those in this category.

MAJOR RELATION

Among the 56 reporting continuing education, 17 indicated whether their major was directly related to their program. 70.6% (12/17) reported direct relation and 29.4% (5/17) reported indirect relation.

CONTINUING EDUCATION (cont'd)

DEGREE LEVEL

Among the 56 reporting continuing education, 39 indicated the degree level they are pursuing. 69.2% (27/39) are pursuing a doctorate degree and 30.8% (12/39) are pursuing a master's degree.

PROGRAM ACCEPTANCE RATE

Among the 56 reporting continuing education, 17 reported the number of program acceptances they received. 47.1% (8/17) received one (1) acceptance, 23.5% (4/17) received two (2) acceptances, and 29.4% (5/17) received four (4) or more acceptances.

FUTURE PLANS FOR STUDY

Among the Class of 2019 graduates responding to the survey, 39 indicated they were planning on (if not actively) pursuing further degrees in the future. Additionally, 23 indicated their plans and timeline for beginning graduate school. Below is a breakdown on these data points.

INTERNSHIPS AND PREPARATION

INTERNSHIP PARTICIPATION

Among the Class of 2019 graduates responding to the survey, 38 indicated how many semesters they participated in an internship experience. 73.7% (28/38) participated in an internship for at least one semester during their time at TCNJ. 39 graduates indicated how many clinical semesters they participated in. 43.6% (17/39) participated in clinical semesters for at least one semester.

CAREER AND GRADUATE SCHOOL PREPARATION

Among the Class of 2019 graduates responding to the survey, 17 rated their level of graduate school preparation. 82.4% (14/17) rated their preparation as above average or excellent. 23 respondents rated their level of preparation for employment, where 95.7% (22/23) rated their preparation as above average or excellent.
