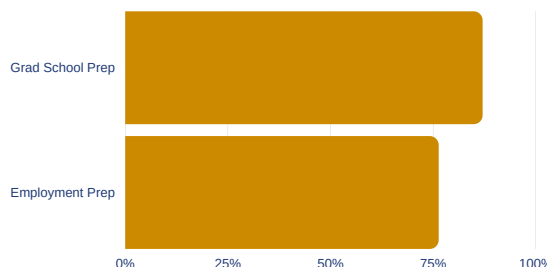
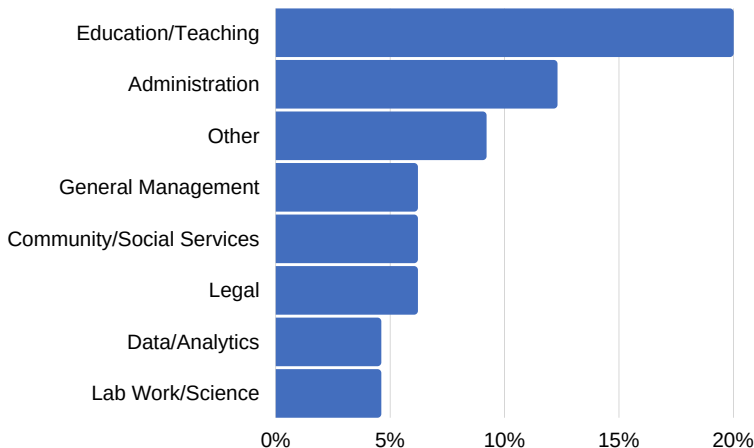
37.1% Information obtained for the One Year Out Survey, or 126/340 eligible graduates.
